COMPILERS NOTES:

The days of the few choices of being gay, straight, and bi are gone. Individuals are tapping into their authentic selves and realizing that there is an entire spectrum of sexual identities. The LGBTQIA Wiki lists 525 different sexual orientation terms. And still more are being created. Many of them have their own pride flags and their own commemorative days. GENERAL FLAG COLOR MEANINGS:

Red or Pink represents feminine characteristics

Blue represents masculine characteristics

Purple represents a combination of both masculine and feminine characteristics

Green represents the non-binary spectrum because it is the inverse of purple (a combination of both red and blue, which are used to represent feminine and masculine)

Yellow represents the non-binary spectrum and the spectrum between the masculine and feminine

Gray or Grey represents semi- or half way point

Black or White represents all, none, or neutral

IDENTITY SYMBOLS:



SEXUAL & ROMANTIC IDENTITIES:



Abinarin – A non-binary individual who is exclusively attracted to other nonbinary individuals (NBLNB).



Abroromantic / Abromantic – An ndividual who experiences their romantic orientation as fluid and/or changing over time. They may also experience changes in the intensity of their attractions.



Abrosexual – An individual whose sexual identity is fluid and changes over time. *Abro* comes from Greek and means "graceful" or "delicate".



Abroromantic / Abromantic – An individual whose romantic orientation is fluid and/or changing over time.



Aceflux – An individual whose sexual orientation fluctuates but generally stays on the Asexual Spectrum.



Achillean – A man or man-aligned individual who is attracted to other men and men-aligned individuals (MLM).



Achillesynian – An individual on the multigender spectrum who are exclusively or non-exclusively attracted men, man-aligned, and masculine-aligned individuals.



Aegoromantic / Anegoromantic / Autochorisromantic – An

individual who enjoys the concept of romance but does not have a desire to participate in romantic activities.



Aegosexual / Anegosexual / Autochorissexual – An individual on the asexual spectrum who has little to no desire to engage in sexual intercourse but

are sexual with themselves. ("aegosexual" and "anegosexual" mean "sexual without self") ("autochoris" means "identity-less")

AGASI – Acronym for Alternative Gender and Sexual Identity.



Akoiromantic – An individual who has a romantic attraction which does not need to be reciprocated.



Alicosexual / Agnosexual – An individual who is on the asexual spectrum, but their sexuality doesn't fit any existing label or they don't know which label fits them best. The romantic counterpart is alicoromantic.

Alterous – A type of love that is neither completely platonic nor romantic.



Alloaesthetic – An individual who is attracted to an individual's appearance.



Alloplatonic – An individual who regularly feels platonic attraction that is a strong desire to be with someone in particular.



Alloromantic – An individual who experiences romantic attraction or is not on the Aromantic Spectrum. Alloromantic individuals regularly experience romantic attraction to other individuals.



Allosensual – An individual who regularly feels sensual attraction. Sensual Attraction, also known as Sensorial Attraction, is a type of physical attraction to another person involving the senses, usually the sense of touch.



Allosexual – An individual who is not asexual.



Ally – A straight and cisgender individual that supports the LGBT* community

and activities.



Amatopunk - An individual who is impacted by amatonormantivity and feels that they do not fit into the binary/cis/het monogamous world.

Androgynephile – An individual that is sexually, romantically, or emotionally attracted to males and females.



Androgynoromantic / Androgyneromantic – An individual who is romantically attracted to individuals expressing femininity and masculinity without implying the gender of the individual experiencing the attraction.



Androphilia – An individual that is sexually, romantically, or emotionally attracted to men and masculinity.



Androromantic – An individual who is romantically attracted to individuals expressing masculinity.



Androsexual – An individual who has sexual feelings towards males, men or masculinity. Used by genderqueer individuals who can't say they are heterosexual nor homosexual.



Animatesexual

/ Animesexual / Mangasexual / Eminafictic – An individual that is exclusively attracted to anime/manga characters. The romantic counterpart is animateromantic.



Aplatonic / Apl – An A-spec individual who does not experience platonic attraction or relate to the concept of platonic love.



Aponian – An individual who is genderless or agender who is attracted to other genderless or agender individuals.



Apothiromantic - An individual who does not feel any romantic attraction and

is repulsed by it.



Apothisexual – An individual who identifies as asexual and finds sex and/or sexual activity to be disgusting or uncomfortable.



Aquamarina – A xenic individual that is exclusively attracted to men (XLM). Xenogender is a term for non-binary gender identities that cannot be described by the usual human interpretations of gender. These individuals are called "Xenics". The feminine equivalent is Tourmalantic and the non-exclusive equivalent is Xenxic.



ARCsexual – An individual who feels Averse, Repulsed, or Conflicted (ARC)

towards sex.



Aroace, Angled – An individual who is Ace-spec and Aro-spec but also identifies with a Non-aroace orientation.



Aroaceflux – An individual who is both aceflux (asexual) and aroflux (aromantic). Their sexual and romantic orientation fluctuates, but generally stays on the asexual and aromantic spectrums.



Aroace, Oriented – An individual who experiences a different form of attraction that is neither romantic nor sexual, but is significant enough to warrant a place alongside their Aroace orientation.



Aroflux – An individual who operates along the aromantic/alloromantic spectrum. They may experience their romantic orientation as fluctuating between experiencing and not experiencing romantic attraction or is being experienced to changing degrees.



Aromantic / Antiromantic

/ Aro – An individual that does not experience romantic attraction towards anyone.



Aromantic Allosexual / Aroallo – An individual experiences sexual attraction but does not experience or has limited romantic attraction.



Aromantic

Asexual / Aroace / Acearo – An individual who does not experience romantic or sexual attraction, making them both aromantic and asexual. Subcategories are: Oriented Aroace, Angled Aroace, and Aroaceflux.

Aromantic Gay / Aro Gay – A male-identified individual who experiences sexual attraction to the same gender but they do not experience romantic attraction.



Aromantic Lesbian / Aro Lesbian – A female-identified individual who experiences sexual attraction to the same gender but they do not experience romantic attraction.



Aromantic Spectrum / Arospec – A spectrum of orientations ranging from Aromantic to Alloromantic. Identities under the umbrella are: Aegoromantic, Apothiromantic, Aroflux, Aromantic/Aro, Bellusromantic, Autoromantic, Cupioromantic, Demiromantic, Desinoromantic, Frayromantic, Grayromantic, Lithromantic, Queerplatonic, Quoiromantic, and Recipromantic.



Aro Vincian / Homoaro / Gay Aromantic – A individual who experiences sexual attraction to the same gender, but they do not experience romantic attraction.



Asensual – An individual who has a lack of sensual attraction including not wanting sensual touch, not interested in sensual activities, or is repulsed by sensual acts.



Asexual – An individual that feels little or no sexual attraction to anyone.



Asexual Gay / Ace Gay – A male-identified individual who identifies as Asexual or Ace-spec and as Homoromantic. This is a variant of Asexual Alloromantic.



Asexual Lesbian / Ace Lesbian – A female-identified individual who identifies as Asexual or Ace-spec and as Homoromantic. This is a variant of Asexual Alloromantic.



Asexual Spectrum / Acespec – Sexual orientations that are asexual or are closely related to asexuality. Identities under the umbrella include: Asexual,

Aceflux, Aegosexual (Anegosexual or Autochorissexual), Apothisexual, Autosexual, Cupiosexual, Demisexuals, Fraysexual, (Ignotasexual), Gray-asexual (Graysexual or Gray-A), and Lithosexual (Akoisexual).



A-spec / A-spectrum – An umbrella term that encompasses both the asexual and aromantic spectra and the many sexual and romantic orientations that are part of them. These orientations involve conditional attractions or experiencing no attraction. Identities under the umbrella are: Asexual Spectrum (Acespec), Aromantic Spectrum (Arospec), and Aromantic Asexual (Aroace and Acearo).



Autoamorous – An individual who desires to be in a relationship with themself as well as to be in a relationship with another individual/other individuals at the same time.



Auto-Bisexual – An individual who is attracted to two or more genders as well

as themselves.



Autochorissexual – An asexual individual that is disconnected from targets of arousal. They may experience sexual fantasies but lack the desire to be a participant in the sexual activities.



Autoflexible – An individual who is primarily autosexual and/or autoromantic, but experiences occasional tendencies to be attracted to others.



Autoromantic – An individual who experiences romantic attraction towards themself. It is the romantic counterpart of autosexual.



Autorose - An individual who is both autosexual and

autoromantic.



Autosexual – An individual

that prefers masturbation over other forms of sexual attraction. Autoromantic is the romantic attraction counterpart. Autoamorous is an individual who desires to date themself and others at the same time. Auto-Bisexual is an individual who is attracted to two or more genders as well as themselves. Autoflux is an individual that fluctuates in Autosexual/Autoromantic attraction. Autorose is an individual who is both Autosexual and Autoromantic. Autoflexible is an individual who is Autosexual and/or Autoromantic but can experience attraction to others occasionally.

Aversefinsexual - An individual who feels attraction towards women and/or womale-aligned individuals, but their attraction has either faded, or they choose not to date them, due to trauma. This term is exclusive to trauma survivors.



Averseminsexual – An individual who feels attraction towards men and/or male-aligned individuals, but their attraction has either faded, or they choose not to date them, due to trauma. This term is exclusive to trauma survivors.



Avid- – An individual whose romantic/sexual/sensual attraction is affected by their Avoidant Personality Disorder (AvPD). This term is exclusive to those who have AvPD.



Avidromantic – An individual whose romantic attraction is affected by their Avoidant Personality Disorder (AvPD). This term is exclusive to those who have AvPD.



Avidsensual – An individual whose sensual attraction is affected by their Avoidant Personality Disorder (AvPD). This term is exclusive to those who have AvPD.



Avidplatonic / Queerplationic – An individual whose platonic relationships are affected by their Avoidant Personality Disorder (AvPD). This term is exclusive to those who have AvPD.



Bambi Lesbian – A lesbian who prefers less-sexual expressions of love such as cuddles, kisses, hugs, and other forms of affection over sexual acts. The Gay/Vincian equivalent is Bambi Gay, and the Bisexual equivalent is Squirrel Bi.

Banjee – A young Latino, Black, or multiracial man, dressing in masculine urban fashion, who has sex with men.



BDSM (Bondage Discipline Sadist Masochist) – A sexual subculture based on the erotic practices of bondage/discipline, dominance/submission, and sado/masochism.



Bear – Husky, hirsute masculine gay men.

Grizzly bears are extremely dominant and typically extremely tall, heavy, or hairy. Chubby bears are heavy set and hairy bears. Pocket bears are short bears. Polar bears are older bears with gray hair. Pandas are bears of Asian descent. Black bears are bears of African-American descent. Brown bears are bears of Latin descent. Koala bears are bears of Australian descent. Otters are hairy men who are lean and muscular. A Wolf is a rugged and outdoorsy bear who is typically a biker. Daddy bears are mature bears who are often looking for a cub. A cub is under-30 and aspires to become a bears. A cub may also describe a bear's husband/partner who fulfills the passive role in the sexual relationship. Chasers are men who are sexually attracted to heavy set gay men. Goldilocks is a female who hangs out with a group of bears.



Bellusromantic – An individual who has an interest in conventionally romantic things without desiring a relationship.



Bellussexual – An asexual individual who is interested in certain sexual actions, the aesthetic of sexual relationships, and/or aspects of sexual relationships, but does not feel sexual attraction and does not want a sexual relationship.

Beyondsexual – An individual in a plural system who feel as if they are beyond human interpretations of sexuality, or that their sexuality cannot be described. This term is exclusive to non-human headmates. (See definition of headmate.)



Bicurious – An individual that is considering experimenting sexually with individuals of the same sex.



Biflexible – An individual who identifies primarily as bisexual, but whose attraction is flexible. They are usually attracted to two or more genders, but might experience occasional changes in the specific genders, number of genders, preference of genders, that they are attracted to.



Bi-Lesbian - An individual who

sometimes identifies as both bisexual, biromantic, or otherwise bi- and a lesbian.



Biphilia / **Ambiphilia** – An individual that is sexually, romantically, or emotionally attracted to both masculinity (men) and femininity (women).



Biromantic – An individual who is romantically

attracted 2 genders, traditionally males and females.



Bisexual – An individual sexually, romantically, or emotionally attracted to both males and females.



Bootblack – Individuals that practice or appreciate bootblacks, the caring for boots, shoes, and other leather apparel.



Boot Fetish – A sexual fetish dedicated to boots.

Caed- / Caedo- – An individual feels that they were once allosexual, but that feeling was taken/cut away from them as a result of past trauma, causing the individual to now feel a lack of attraction. The term is exclusive to trauma survivors. The prefix can be added to the following identities: Caedsexual,



Caedromantic – An Aro-spec identity.

Caedaroace – An Aroace-spec identity (is the combination of Caedsexual and Caedromantic).



Caedqueerplatonic – A Queerplatonic identity.



Caedsensual – A sensual attraction identity.



Caligosexual – An individual who feels very weak or vague sexual attraction that is almost nonexistent, like a vapor, fog, or mist.



Callistic – An Aromantic or A-spec individual who does not want a queerplatonic relationship, close friendship, or anything similar.



Carnic – A xenic or xenogender individual is exclusively attracted to other xenic/xenogender individuals (XLX). The non-exclusive equivalent to carnic is Xyric.



Cassexual – An individual who feels indifferent toward sexuality and believes it is not an important part of their identity.

Celibate – An individual who abstains from all sexual activity. These individuals can have any sexual orientation but do not act on it.



Ceteramoric / Ceteroamoric / Teramoric – A Non-binary and/or Genderqueer individual who is exclusively attracted to other Non-binary and/or Genderqueer individuals.



Chameleoromantic – An individual who wishes to be treated as a woman when interacting romantically with men and as a man when interacting romantically with women. They choose when or if they want to receive or perform romantic/sexual acts based on the gender of their partner.



Chameleosexual – An individual who sexually versatile depending on the gender of their partner. The individual wishes to be treated as a woman when interacting sexually with men and as a man when interacting sexually with women. It may be used interchangeably with lamvanosexual and Placiosexual referring to when one prefers to receive or perform sexual acts based on the gender of their partner.



Chav Fetish – A sexual fetish dedicated to Chavs or Charvers, meaning a young lower-class person who displays brash and loutish behavior and wears real or imitation designer clothes.



Comsexual – An individual who experiences attraction. It is the opposite of asexual however it is different from allosexual. Allosexual is an umbrella term, and can refer to anyone, homosexual, heterosexual, bi, pan, etc, who commonly feels sexual attraction. Comsexual is a specific identity for someone who feels sexual attraction and can't/doesn't want to specify their identity any farther than that.



Cowboy Fetish – A sexual fetish dedicated cowboys.



Cryptosexual – An individual who is puzzled by their orientation and as such it cannot be discerned, described or defined using current English vocabulary or words. There is no

pattern to how, when, or to whom they feel or don't feel attraction. If they attempt describe their orientation, they feel "lost".



Cupid Asexual / Cupid Ace – An asexual individual who still experiences a small form of sexual attraction. The romantic counterpart is Cupid Aromantic.



Cupioromantic – An individual who does not experience attraction but does desire a romantic relationship.



Cupiosexual – An individual who does not experience sexual attraction but still desires/likes a sexual relationship. They may also desire a sexual relationship even without attraction.



Deiatic – A god/deity/celestial being in a system is only or primarily attracted to or wishes to date another god/deity/celestial being. This may only be used in systems of individuals with Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions. It can be used as modifier for other sexualities, Deiaticpan, Deiaticgay, Deiaticace, etc.



Dellosexual – An individual who experiences attraction to multiple genders and experiences allosexual style attraction to some genders but is demisexual towards other genders.



Deltheon / Deltian / Delthian / Delteon / Deltion / Mesrien /

Jupiteric – An umbrella term for bi-straights, pan-straights, omni-straights, and poly-straights. These M-spec straights are individuals who identify as both straight and multisexual in some way.



Demi / Demian / Demirose / Demi Squared / Demi-Aroace -

An individual who is both Demisexual and Demiromantic. They must have a strong emotional

bond with someone before sexual and romantic attraction can be felt towards them. Demi can be a prefix attached to any other sexual identity.



Demibisexual – An individual who is sexually attracted to at least two genders but needing to feel a deep emotional connection with an individual before feeling sexual attraction towards them.



Demigrayromantic / Demigreyromantic / Demigrayaromantic / Demigrayro

- An individual who rarely or infrequently experiences romantic attraction only after they have formed a deep connection with someone.



Demigraysexual / Demigreysexual / Demigrayasexual / Demigrayace - An

individual who rarely or infrequently experiences sexual attraction and only after they have formed a deep connection with someone.



Demilesbian – A woman-identified individual who is attracted to other women or woman-aligned individuals, but needs a strong emotional connection to form a sexual attraction.



Demipansexual – An individual who is attracted to multiple genders but does not feel sexually-inclined to a person unless a serious relationship is developed and a certain level of trust is gained.



Demiromantic – An individual who feels sexual attraction only after a strong emotional bond has been formed.



Demiromanticspike / Exceptional-Demiromantic – An individual who is normally demiromantic, and requires a strong emotional connection with someone before feeling romantic attraction. However, rarely they experience romantic attraction without having an emotional connection.



Demisapphic – A woman-identified individual who is attracted to other women or woman-aligned individuals, but needs a strong emotional connection to form a sexual attraction.



Demisexual – An individual who does not feel sexual attraction until a strong emotional bond has formed.



Demisexualspike / Exceptional-Demisexual – An individual who requires a strong emotional connection with someone before feeling sexual attraction. However, they experience rare cases where they feel sexual attraction without having an emotional connection.



Depri- – An individual may feel less attraction on days with high depression levels. This term is exclusive to those who have depression.



Desinoromantic – An individual who does not experience full-on romantic attraction, but does experience liking someone instead of loving them romantically; the attraction then goes no further.



Diamoric / Adonian / Adonic / Cypric / Dionysian – An umbrella term referring to the attractions experienced by non-binary individuals that cannot be described as "same gender" or "other gender", "straight" or "gay". Diamoric can also describe relationships in which one or more of the individuals is non-binary. Identities under the umbrella are: Trixic, Toric, Orbisian, Quadrisian, Non-binary individuals loving non-binary individuals (NBLNB), Non-binary individuals loving women (NBLW), and Non-binary individuals loving men (NBLW).



Dualrose – An individual who wants or enjoys the idea of both sexual and romantic activities/attraction but after a short period, feels strongly sex-repulsed and romance-repulsed.



Dysphorsexual / Dyssexual – An

individual's sexuality is limited or affected by dysphoria. A dysphorsexual individual might also feel like no one would want to be with them or they might not want someone to feel attraction to them because their dysphoria is so bad.



Dysphorsexual (Non-Binary) – A non-binary individual's sexuality is limited or affected by dysphoria.



Ecosexual – An environmentally conscious individual who recognizes Mother Earth through acts of masturbating in nature, making love to Mother Earth, marrying Earth or her other natural elements. They use eco-friendly and sustainable birth control, sex toys, and lubricants.



Eligereromantic – An individual who feels that they can choose if they feel romantic attraction to certain people or not. They feel that their romantic attraction is something that they can choose where it directs to, and choose whether to feel romantic attraction or not.



Eligeresexual – An individual who feels that they can choose if they feel sexual attraction to certain people or not. They feel that their sexual attraction is something that they can choose where it directs to, and choose whether to feel sexual attraction or not.



Electio Aroace – An individual who is Aromantic, Asexual and does not experience any form of tertiary attraction. They desire and seek out relationships, whether this be sexual, romantic, queerplatonic, etc.



Enbian – A non-binary individual who is attracted exclusively or non-exclusively to other non-binary individuals (NBLNB).



Encephalosexual / Encephalsexual / Enciesexual / Encie – An individual who does not experience sexual attraction until an intellectual bond is formed, or until one experiences mental attraction. '



Enersexual – An individual who is sexually or romantically attracted to other individual's energy regardless of their gender identity, anatomy, or presentation. They seek out partners that can provide the most intense or deepest connections.



Enigmasexual – An individual who feels attraction so rarely, vaguely or weakly that they don't know the specifics of the orientation, such the genders they're attracted to or the fluidity of the orientation. No specific pattern or trend can be quantified or detected.



Erased Sexualities – The action of ignoring, removing, falsifying, or reexplaining evidence of any type of sexuality in history, academia, the news media, and other primary sources. In its most extreme form, it can include the belief that a sexuality itself does not exist.



Esthesiosexual – An individual who desires a relationship with non-intercourse sexual activities. Rather they prefer outercourse, or sensual actions/intentions.



Europic – An Aromantic or A-spec individual who is more emotionally involved than a typical friendship but they do not want to completely commit to a partner.

Ex-gay – An individual who changed their sexual orientation to heterosexual as a result of participating in ex-gay therapy.



Exterior Angled Polyamory / Plus One

Polyamory – A type of quad polyamorous relationship in which 3 people have a triad and one person is also dating someone else.



Factivesexual – An entity in a system that only wants to date

and are only attracted to other factives. This term can also be used as factiveromantic and factiveplatonic. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Fat Fetish – A sexual fetish dedicated to overweight individuals.



Feminamoric - A Non-binary individual who is attracted to

women.



Fictivesexual – An entity in a system that only wants to date and are only attracted to other fictives. This term can also be used as fictiveromantic and fictiveplatonic. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Fictofamilial / Fictoplatonic – An individual that is emotionally attracted to fictional characters.



Fictomantic / Fictoromantic – An individual that is romantically

attracted to fictional characters.



Fictoqueer – An individual who identifies with a ficto- orientation, such as fictosexual, fictoromantic and fictoalterous



Fictosexual – An individual that is sexually attracted to fictional characters or whose sexuality is influenced by fictional characters.



Fiduciaamorous – A polyamorous attraction in which an individual can feel attraction to multiple beings at the same time and would like to be in a polyamorous relationship, but only after trust is fully realized. This is an exclusive orientation for those who have trust issues, bad experiences and/or trauma with polyamory/relationships.



Finflexible – An individual who usually experiences Finsexual attraction, with the occasional attraction to non-feminine-aligned genders or individuals that don't present femininely.



Finromantic – An individual who is exclusively romantically attracted to those who are feminine in nature (hence the term FIN).



Finsexual – An individual who is exclusively attracted to those who are feminine in nature (hence the term FIN).





Foot/Feet Fetish – A sexual fetish dedicated to feet and related fetishes (hosiery, footwear, foot jobs, submission, crushing, shrimping, etc.).



Frayromantic – An individual who feels romantic attraction to people that they do not have a strong emotional bond with. Once they form an emotional bond with that person, that attraction disappears or fades.



Fraysexual / Ignotasexual – An individual who only experiences sexual attraction towards those that they are not deeply connected with and lose that attraction as they get to know the person.



Freak – Individuals with tattoos, piercings, body modifications, unique or strange outward appearances, and fetish wear.



Furry Canine – Individuals who into anthropomorphic animal characters with human personalities and characteristics, particularly those of the dog family. Also known as Yiffy, Anthro or Morph community.



Furry Feline – Individual who are into anthropomorphic animal characters with human personalities and characteristics, particularly those of the cat family. Also known as Yiffy, Anthro or Morph community.

Fuscsexual - An individual whose orientation changes while experiencing a depressive episode. This identity is exclusive to those with Bipolar Disorder.



Gai – A non-binary individual who is gay but in a unique way because how is the "opposite" gender determined? A non-binary person may consider only some of their attractions to be not-straight, or all of them to be so. The term is similar in meaning to queer but specific to Non-binary people.



Galaxromantic - An individual who feels that using the label "ceteromantic" would be inappropriate to describe their attraction.



Galaxsexual – An individual who feels that using the label "ceterosexual" would be inappropriate to describe their attraction.



Gamyflux / Amoryflux - An individual who fluctuates across the nonmonogamous and monogamous spectrums.



Gasmask Fetish – A sexual fetish dedicated to gas masks.



Gay Cowboy – A sexual fetish dedicated gay cowboys.



Gay Gothic Sexuality – Gay individuals into the gothic sex scene.



Gothic Sexuality – Individuals into the gothic sex scene.



Grayromantic / Greyromantic – An individual who feels very low amounts of romantic attraction, rarely feel romantic attraction, only feel romantic attraction under specific circumstances, or are not sure if they experience romantic attraction.



Graysexual / Greysexual / Grey Asexual / Grey-A / Grey-Ace – An individual who falls somewhere between asexual and allosexual, but does not want to be defined as specifically asexual.



Graymasfluid – An individual who is graysexual but may fluctuate between man-aligned sexualities or male individuals.



Gynephilia – An individual that is sexually attracted to women and femininity.



Gyneromantic / Gynoromantic – An individual who is romantically attracted to individuals expressing femininity.



Gynesexual / **Gynosexual** – An individual who it attracted to females, women or femininity This is a term that may be utilized by non-binaries.

Headmate – An imaginary friend or an alternate personality in an individual with Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID) or Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions. A headmate is a singular entity in a plural system or collective in one body. "Alter" is the clinical term for a person inside a system. "Headmate/sysmate" is a non-clinical alternative.



Heteroromantic – An individual who is romantically attracted to individuals with a gender other than their own.





Heterosexual / Straight / Cishet – An individual who feels sexual attraction to

individuals of the opposite gender when referring to binary cisgender individuals of male or female.



Heteroflexible – A heterosexual individual that is open to the possibilities of having a romantic, emotional, or sexual homosexual relationship.



Homosexual / Gay (Man) - A male-identified individual who

is sexually attracted to other males.



Homoflexible – A homosexual individual that is open to the possibilities of having a romantic, emotional, or sexual heterosexual relationship.



Homoromantic – A male–identified individual who is romantically or emotionally attracted to other males or an individual who is romantically attracted to individuals of the same gender in a binary gender system.



Idemromantic – An individual who experiences romantic and platonic feelings in the same way.



Human Rights Campaign – An organization that works for LGBTQ+ equality

and human rights.

Idemromantic – An individual who is able to categorize relationships and feelings as platonic or romantic based on outside factors, but experiences no notable internal differences between platonic and romantic feelings.



Introsexual – An introjects in system that only want to date and are only attracted to other introjects. This term can also be used for other forms of attraction, such as intromantic and introplatonic. Terms under this umbrella include Fictivesexual and Factivesexual. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Iridian – An individual who is woman/woman-aligned and non-binary, and is either exclusively or non-exclusively attracted to women and non-binary individuals (WLW, WLNB, NBLNB, and NBLW). The MLM, MLNB, NBLNB, and NBLM equivalent is Opalian.



Kinsexual / **Kinromantic** – A sexual and/or romantic orientation that is exclusive to Otherkin beings. It may be related to one's kintype being a alterhuman/non-human identity. Example identities include: Lurric, Ductuaffectis, Kinshiftsexualflux, Bambi Non-Human, Xenor, and Anuafsexual. Otherkin are individuals who identify as not entirely human. Some otherkin believe their identity derives from reincarnation, a non-human soul, ancestry, symbolism, metaphor, or unusual psychology. Categories of otherkin include Fictionkin, those who identify as fictional characters; Conceptkin, who identify as abstract concepts; Weatherkin, who identify as weather systems; as well as a number of other more categories.



Larimarian – An individual who is both exclusively or non-exclusively manloving-woman (MLW) and woman-loving-woman (WLW). The man-loving counterpart is Diamondian and the non-binary-loving counterpart is Topazian.



Leather - A sexual subculture based on styles of dress organized around sexual activities. Wearing leather garments is associated with BDSM (Bondage/Discipline, Dominance/Submission, Sado/Masochism).



Lesbian

 A female-identified individual who is sexually, romantically, or emotionally attracted to other females.



Lesbian, Butch – A lesbian who has masculine personality traits. A black lesbian butch is called a "stud".



Lesbian-Flexible – A lesbian who is open to the possibilities of having a romantic, emotional, or sexual heterosexual relationship.



Lesbian, Lipstick – A lesbian who has feminine personality traits.



Lesboy / Boy-male-man Lesbian – A individual who identifies as both a boy/man and a lesbian. A cisgender binary male cannot be a Lesboy due to the fact that lesbian attraction is queer and a binary cisgender male cannot experience queer attraction to women.



LGBTQ+ 1978 Pride Flag (1st) 8 Stripes – The original "rainbow" flag designed

by Gilbert Baker.



LGBTQ+ 1978 Pride Flag (2nd) 7 Stripes – The second version of the "rainbow" flag. The pink stripe was eliminated from the original version of the flag.



LGBTQ+ 1979 Pride (3rd) 6 Stripes – The now traditional "rainbow" flag symbol for the entire LGBTQ+ community. The pink and turquoise stripes were eliminated from the original version of the flag.



LGBTQ+ 2017 Philadelphia People of Color Inclusive – The city of Philadelphia, led by Amber Hikes, added black and brown to the rainbow pride flag in honor of the many underrepresented queer people of color (POC).



LGBTQ+ 2018 Progress Pride – Designed by Daniel Quasar, this flag includes non-binary individuals, people of color, and trans.



LGBTQI+ 2021 Intersex Progress Pride – Designed by Valentino Vecchietti, this rainbow flag includes those who are intersex, people of color, and trans as well as gay.



LGBT Marriage Equality – Legal recognition of "same-sex" marriages.

Line Relationship – A polyamorous relationship in which younger partners are added to the relationship as older partners age.



Lithromantic / Lithoromantic / Akoiromantic / Akoiromantic / Akoiromantic / Akoineromantic – An individual who feels romantic attraction but does not want it reciprocated, or loses that attraction when it is reciprocated.



Lithsexual – An individual that feels attraction but does not want the feeling returned in any way.



Longhaired Fetish – A fetish dedicated to longhairs.



Lunian - An umbrella term for bi-lesbians, pan-lesbians, omni-

lesbians, poly-lesbians and other M-spec lesbian orientations. An M-spec lesbian is an individual who identifies as both a lesbian and multisexual in some way.



Marsic – A Non-binary individual who is exclusively attracted to men, menaligned people, and Solarians.



Masexual / Mansexual – An individual who is exclusively attracted to men. The term includes binary men and masculine-aligned non-binary individuals. The female equivalent to is Womasexual. Maromantic is the romantic counterpart.



Master Slave – A BDSM subculture in which master/slave is a relationship in which one individual (the submissive) gives ultimate authority to another (the dominant).



Mercuric – An individual who is attracted to men, women, feminine-aligned nonbinary people, masculine-aligned non-binary people, Solarians, Lunarians, Novarians, and Nebularians. They attracted to everyone except non-aligned non-binary people or Stellarians.



/ Hexian – An individual who identifies as both M-spec Lesbian and M-spec Veldian/Turian, either being fluid between them or being both simultaneously.

Microlabel - A label of gender identity or sexual orientation that falls under or overlaps with, a broader term.



Military Uniform Fetish – A sexual fetish dedicated to military uniforms.



Minsexual – An individual who is exclusively attracted to those who are masculine in nature. Minromantic is the romantic counterpart. Minflexible is the flexible variant, an individual who also has an occasional attraction to non-masculine-aligned genders or individuals that don't present as masculine.



MOGAI – Marginalized Orientations, Gender Alignment, and Intersex. An umbrella term for individuals who are not cisgender and/or heterosexual.



Monoromantic – An individual who is romantically attracted to individuals of only one gender identity.



Monosexual – An individual that is sexually and romantically attracted one gender or to individuals that identify as one gender i.e. loving males (androphilia) or loving females (gynephilia).



Multisexual Spectrum /

M-Spec / Pluralian – An individual who is attracted to more than one gender. It is considered an umbrella term that includes labels characterized by attraction to more than one gender. Multisexual can also be a stand-alone identity for anyone who does not know where they stand on the spectrum or does not wish to specify their sexuality any further. The opposite of multisexual is monosexual. Multiromantic is the romantic counterpart.



Muscle – Individuals who are muscle enthusiasts or who have a fetish for muscular individuals or for building muscle mass.



Mutoic / Mutosexual – An individual whose orientation changes in response to a situation. It is the orientation counterpart to mutogender. More specific terms are: Mutoicsexual (sexuality), Mutoicromantic (romantic orientation), Mutoic-attracted/Mutoic-attractional (attraction), Mutoicamorous/Mutoamorous (amory), or Mutoic-ace/Mutoic-aro/mutoic-aroace (Aroace-spec).



Mutolic / Mutalic / Alter Loving Alter (ATLAT) / Headmate

Loveing Headmate (HLH) – An umbrella term for individuals who are in a system where one or more of their headmates are attracted to other headmate(s) of a specific gender(s). This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions. Terms under this umbrella include:

-Near / Near- - Used as both a prefix and suffix on any gender identity or sexual orientation an individual that feels extremely close to fitting a certain label, but there is something slightly off, missing, or different about it.



Nebularoace – An individual who is both nebulasexual and nebularomantic.



Nebularomantic – A individual who is unable to or has difficulty identifying the difference between romantic and platonic attraction because of their neurodivergencies. The term is exclusive to neurodivergent individuals.



Nebulasexual – An individual who cannot tell if they experience sexual attraction or not due to their neurodivergencies and/or intrusive thoughts/urges. They have difficulty identifying the difference between sexual attraction and other types of attraction. The term is exclusive to neurodivergent individuals or those who experience intrusive thoughts/urges/images.



Neptunic / Nomascsexual - An individual who is attracted

to women and non-binary individuals that aren't man-aligned. It is also attraction to all people except men and/or man-aligned non-binary people. This orientation is mostly used by non-binary people.



Neurosexual – An individual whose neurodivergence/neurodiversity, and sometimes general mental health, affects their orientation in some way. Neurosexualities are exclusive to those with neurodivergency and cannot be used by neurotypicals. Neuroromantic is the romantic counterpart.



Neutric – An individual who is neutrois and is, exclusively or not, attracted to other neutrois individuals (NLN). The exclusive attraction counterpart is Nuumian.



Neutroisromantic – An individual who is romantically attracted to individuals of null, non–gendered, or non–binary gender identity.



Ninsexual – An individual who is exclusively attracted to those who are neutral or non-binary in nature. A Ninsexual can experience attraction to any neutral/androgynous and/or any neutral/non-binary genders. This also includes non-binary individuals who present masculine or feminine. The masculine equivalent in Minsexual. The feminine equivalent is Finsexual. The xenic equivalent is Xinsexual. Ninromantic is the romantic counterpart. Ninflexible is the flexible variant. Someone who is ninflexible usually experiences ninsexual attraction, with the occasional attraction to non-neutral-aligned genders or individuals that don't present as androgynous.



Nonaesthetic / A-aesthetic / Ansthetic / Anaesthetic – An individual who does not feel aesthetic attraction towards any gender. One can still be romantically or sexually attracted to someone but their attraction does not revolve around one's appearance. One may abbreviate the term Anaesthetic to Anae, Nonae or Aae. The Nonaesthetic Spectrum is abbreviated as "Aespec".



Noetic – An individual whose attraction is based on appreciating and being interested in one's opinions, point of view, perception of reality, how they see the world, and how their mind works.



Noetisexual – An individual who is only attracted to those that they are mentally connected to, based on their opinions, point of view, perception of reality, world view, and how their mind works.



Novisexual – An individual who feels complicated attraction or lack thereof in such a way that it is difficult or impossible to fit into one term.



Nonhumansexual – Non-human headmates in systems, that are attracted to other non-human headmates or have a preference for other non-human headmates (NHLNH). This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Nuumian – An individual who is neutrois and is exclusively attracted to other neutrois individuals (NLN). The non-exclusive attraction counterpart is Neutric.



Objectum Sexuality / Objectum / Objectum Romanticism (OS/OR) / Pygmaliosexual – An individual who is sexually and/or romantically attracted to inanimate objects.



Omniacepomo – An individual who is unsure where they are on the asexual spectrum and has no preference for the gender of their partner.



Omnisexual – An individual that is sexually, romantically, or emotionally attracted to individuals of all genders, but gender is still a factor in how they feel.. Omnisexuality differs from pansexuality, which specifically states that gender is not a factor in the individual's attraction. The romantic equivalent is Omniromantic.



Opalian – A man/man-aligned non-binary individual who is either exclusively or non-exclusively attracted to men and non-binary individuals (MLM, MLNB, NBLNB, and NBLM). The WLW, WLNB, NBLNB, and NBLW equivalent is Iridian.

Opueste – An individual who is heterosexual (attracted to the opposite gender or a generally different gender their own) however, due to trauma, they are triggered by, made uncomfortable by, or otherwise mentally unable to identify with the term straight/heterosexual without it having a negative impact on oneself. This identity is exclusive to those who have experienced trauma.



Orchidsexual – An individual who experiences sexual attraction, but does not desire a sexual relationship or encounter. They may consider others to be sexually attractive, but they would lack the desire to have sexual experiences.

Oscillsexual – An individual whose orientation changes while experiencing a Bipoloar episode be it mixed, manic, hypomanic, depressive etc. This identity is exclusive to those with Bipolar Disorder. This term can also be considered an umbrella term with the terms under it being Fuscsexual (depressive episodes) and Petosexual (manic/hypomanic episodes).



Otherkinian – An otherkin individual who is exclusively or near-exclusively attracted to otherkin individuals. Otherkin are individuals who identify as not entirely human. Some otherkin believe their identity derives from reincarnation, a non-human soul, ancestry, symbolism, metaphor, or unusual psychology. Categories of otherkin include Fictionkin, those who identify as fictional characters; Conceptkin, who identify as abstract concepts; Weatherkin, who identify as weather systems; as well as a number of other more categories.



Ownership – A BDSM subculture in which master/slave is a relationship in which one individual (the submissive) gives ultimate authority to another (the dominant).

Panphilia – An individual that is sexually, romantically, or emotionally attracted to individuals of all genders.



Panromantic – An individual who has a romantic attraction toward people regardless of their sex or gender identity. The sexual equivalent of this is pansexual.



Pansexual – An individual that is sexually, romantically, or emotionally attracted to all individuals regardless of their sex or gender identity. Panflux describes being pansexual but experiencing fluctuating parts.



Parasexual – An individual who enjoys recreational sex (sex for the purpose of pleasure rather than reproduction without the commitment of a relationship) despite not experiencing sexual attraction to those involved.



Pencontrasexual – An individual who is attracted to all genders except the gender that is the "opposite" or "other" of their own. What gender is "opposite" of one's identity must be determined by the individual.



Penultisexual – An individual who is attracted to all genders except their own.

Petosexual – An individual whose orientation changes whilst experiencing a manic or hypomanic episodes. This identity is exclusive to those with Bipolar Disorder.



Placiosexual – An individual who enjoys performing sexual acts for other individuals but does not want them reciprocated.



Pleonotic – An individual who identifies with a certain gender term but does not use/does not identify with other synonymous terms for that identity.



Polarsexual – An individual who switches

between being strongly allosexual, to completely asexual and/or sex-repulsed, usually with no inbetween state.



Polarromantic – An individual who switches between being strongly alloromantic, to completely aromantic and/or romantic-repulsed, usually with no in-between state...



Polarsensual – An individual who switches between being strongly allosensual, to completely asensual and/or sensual-repulsed, usually with no in-between state.



Polyacor / Polyaco – An individual who experiences attraction to multiple beings that one wants to act on, but at the same time has a strong aversion to engaging in it due to bad experiences, apprehension, or other misgivings about being involved in polyamorous relationships. This identity is used by people with PTSD or other trauma involving sexual experiences, by neurodivergent or disabled people, or by anyone who feels a strong aversion to acting on attraction to multiple people. The romantic and sexual counterparts of this are Acorsexual and Acoromantic.



Polyamorous – An individual who desires or

practices having more than one intimate partner at a time with the consent of all individuals involved.



Poly-Lesbian / Ply-Lesbian -

A lesbian who identifies as both Polysexual, Polyromantic, or otherwise Ply-. They may feel one form of attraction to many but not all genders and another form of attraction to women or non-
men. The poly-lesbian label is also used by some individuals with fluid attraction, duosexuality, or abrosexuality between ply and lesbian. The counterparts of this identity consist of Omni-lesbian, Bi-lesbian, and Pan-lesbian.



Polyromantic – An individual who is romantically attracted to many, but not all, genders, and not necessarily involving sexual attraction.



Polysexual – An individual who is sexually attracted to various, but not necessarily all, genders.



Polytra – An individual who was and/or felt like they were once polyamorous but, due to trauma, they are now monogamous. This term may only be used by those who have PTSD, C-PTSD, or trauma-formed disorders.



Pomosexual – Short for "postmodernly sexual", which means an individual has refuses, avoids, or does not fit any sexual orientation label. They disregard gender and sexual labels altogether. From the book *PoMoSexuals: Challenging Assumptions about Gender and Sexuality* edited by Carol Queen and Lawrence Schimel. The romantic equivalent is Pomoromantic.



Pony – Fetish play where people are treated like horses by wearing hooves, ears, and saddles. Carrie P created this flag in 2007.



Proculsexual – An asexual individual only feels sexual attraction to individuals who they can never be in a relationship with.



Proquasexual – A feminine individual who is exclusively attracted to feminine

individuals.



Proquusexual – A masculine individual who is exclusively attracted to masculine people.



Puppy/Dog Play -

Individuals into anthropomorphic dog characters with human personalities and characteristics.



Quadsexual – An individual who is attracted to exactly 4 genders. These could be any 4 genders and the attraction could be experienced either as static or fluid attraction.



Queer – An individual or community of people who are not cisgender heterosexual. Queer can also refer to gender identity or gender expression, whether as a standalone term or part of another. The "Q" in LGBTQIA+ and similar acronyms commonly means Queer. As a reclaimed word, it has been used in fights for LGBTQIA+ rights and liberation as an inclusive and defiant term.



Queerplatonic Relationship – A close non-sexual, non-romantic relationship that is beyond what most would consider to be a friendship. Individuals in queerplatonic relationships may be of any gender or sexual identity.



Questioning – An individual who is exploring, learning, or experimenting with their sexual orientation, romantic orientation, or gender identity.



-

Questian / A? – An individual who does not know their sexuality/romantic orientation due to their place in the Ace/Aro Spectrum. This is exclusive to those who are Ace-Spec and/or Aro-Spec. An individual might also be questioning and/or quoi- in addition to being questian. Questian identities include:



Expeditian – An individual is actively trying to find out what their true romantic/sexual attraction is.



Journian – An individual need/want to find what true romantic/sexual attraction is, but understand it might take more time for them, so they don't actively seek it out.



Wanderian – An individual doesn't need or want to find what their true romantic or sexual attraction is.



Quintsexual – An individual who is attracted to exactly 5 genders. These could be any 5 genders and the attraction could be experienced either as static or fluid attraction.



Quoiromantic – An individual who is unable to distinguish the difference between romantic and platonic feelings, or cannot define romantic attraction, therefore does not know whether or not they have experienced it.



Quoisexual – An individual Quoisexual (also called WTFsexual or Whatsexual) is a sexual equivalent of quoiromantic. It can also be considered a catchall or umbrella term for similar identities.



Recipromantic – An individual who only experiences romantic attraction after knowing that the other person is romantically attracted to them.



Reciprosexual / Recipsexual – An individual who does not experience sexual attraction unless they know that the other individual is sexually attracted to them first. Reciprosexual can be a sexual orientation on its own or can be combined with other orientations.



Religeisexual – An individual whose sexuality has been affected negatively by their current or previous religion. This term is exclusive to those who are/were practicing a religion at some point in their life. Religeiamorous is the same but is focused only on amory.



Requiesromantic – An individual who has little to no romantic attraction because of some mental or emotional exhaustion, likely due to bad experiences of romance in the past.



Roseromantic - An individual who wants or enjoys the idea

of romantic attraction/romantic activities, but become romance-repulsed after a certain period of time. The sexual-romantic counterpart is dualrose.



Rosesexual – An individual who wants or enjoys the idea of

sexual activity and sexual attraction but after a short period feels strongly sex-repulsed. The sexual-romantic counterpart is dualrose.



Rubber – A fetish dedicated to rubber or latex clothing and sheets.



Salietian - A woman/feminine-aligned individual who, either

exclusive or non-exclusive, is both woman-loving-woman (WLW) and woman-loving-man (WLM). Individuals included in this label are any multisexual women/feminine-aligned genders attracted to both men and women. The male-loving counterpart is Rochillic and the non-binary-loving counterpart is Scapolitian. Salietian's definition and its name is a combination of Sapphic (WLW) and Julietian (WLM).



Sapphic – An individual, sometimes known as woman loving

woman (WLW), or sapphist, is a woman of any sexual orientation who is attracted to other women. This label includes all woman-identifying entities including: Lesbian, Pansexual, Bisexual, or Queer.



Saturnic – An individual who is attracted to androgynous-aligned non-binary individuals, including Androgynes, Ambonec individuals, Aaturnians, Eclipsians, Galaxians, Celestarians, and other lingender individuals. Similar terms include Androgynesexual, Ceteramoric, Ceterosexual, Enbian, Enboric, Stellaric, and Terraric. The feminine equivalent is Neptunic. The masculine equivalent is Uranic.



Skolioromantic / **Ceteroromantic** / **Transromantic** – An individual who is romantically attracted to individuals of variant, non-binary, or ambiguous gender or to transgender, genderqueer, or intersex individuals.



Skoliosexual / Ceterosexual / Allotroposexual – An individual that is sexually or romantically attracted to individuals of variant, non-binary, or ambiguous gender or to transgender, genderqueer, or intersex individuals.



Skinhead Fetish – Individuals who are into skinhead culture.



Skinhead Fetish, Gay – Individuals who are into skinhead culture. (The gay skinhead culture is generally not racially biased.)

Slidesexual – An individual with age-sliding headmates in plural systems who feel that their sexuality changes when they age slide. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Solian – An alternate term for M-spec Turians/Veldians that is an umbrella term for Bi-veldians, Pan-veldians, Omni-veldians, Poly-veldians and other M-spec Veldian orientations. The M-spec lesbian equivalent is Lunian, the M-spec straight equivalent is Deltheon, and the m-spec gay equivalent is stellian.



Sourcesexual – An individual's sexual orientation does not align with their sources yet they still feel a connection to their source's sexual orientation. An Sourcesexual individual may feel as if they are supposed to have that orientation, despite not knowing they don't fully identify as such. This term can also be used as a prefix for other attraction types such as Sourceromantic or Sourceplatonic, etc. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Sourcivo – An individual who has an exclusive attraction, near exclusive attraction, or preference to others from their source. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Spectrasexual – An

individual who feels sexual attraction to individuals who fall in a spectrum of many gender identities. Spectrasexual individuals experience attraction to multiple genders, but not all. Spectrasexual may be differentiated from polysexual by the experience of attraction to a spectrum of many identities rather than attraction to many, possibly scattered or select, identities. Omnisexuality means that someone is attracted to all genders, with some preferences.



Spirian – An ghostkin/spiritkin individual who is, exclusively or not, attracted to other ghostkin/spiritkin individuals. Also, a ghost/spirit headmate in a system who is, exclusively or not, attracted to other ghost/spirit headmates. These definitions can be abbreviated to ghost-loving-ghost (GLG) or spirit-loving-spirit (SIS). The term can be modified to specify the type of attraction experienced (Spirisexual, Spiriromantic, Spirisensual, Spiriplatonic, etc.). This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Sporadic-Ace – An individual on the asexual spectrum whose sexual attraction does not follow a specific pattern and feels sporadic. The individual will experience sexual attraction at a randomized rate, meaning that they may never fit a consistent label otherwise. The gender counterpart is Gender-Sporadic.



Sporadic-Aro – An individual on the aromantic spectrum whose romantic attraction does not follow a specific pattern and feels sporadic. The individual will experience romantic attraction at a randomized rate, meaning that they may never fit a consistent label otherwise. The gender counterpart is Gender-Sporadic.



Straight Queer / Queer Het / Heteroqueer – A cisgender heterosexual person who is gender non-conforming, a person on the multi-attracted spectrum who has a strong preference for a different gender than their own, or a heterosexual and/or a heteroromantic person who identifies with any queer label. Straight queer in the queer community historically meant a queer person who "looked straight" by confirming cisheteronormative gender roles or was straight-passing. It has also referred to cisgender heterosexual (cishet) men who do not conform to hetero-masculinity and those who are allies.



Stresexual – An individual's who feels that their trauma, trauma recovery, mental disorders, mental disabilities, or other conditions that affect their health limit their ability to experience attraction. This identity is open to anyone who feels as though their mental health effects or limits their attraction. These individuals may feel as though they are no longer able to be attracted to a specific gender, sex, gender modality, a specific type of individual, an individual with a specific religion or culture, or an individual with a specific feature or personality trait, etc.



Switch – A BDSM subculture that represents the role of the Switch.



Teratosexual / Monstrosexual / Monstersexual – A Fictosexual individual who is attracted solely to sapient monsters that can consent. The original definition was sexual attraction to demons/monsters. A similar term is Anuafsexual.



Terraric – A Non-binary individual who is exclusively attracted to non-binary people and Stellarians.



Torenflex – An individual who is primarily attracted to men and non-binary individuals, but experiences flexibility in this attraction so that it is not exclusive.



Torensexual / Torenamoric – An individual who is exclusively

attracted to men and non-binary people.



Toric / Quadrisian – A

non-binary individual who is, exclusively or not, attracted to men. The term can be shortened to non-binary-loving-men (NBLM). Viramoric in an individual whose attraction is exclusive. The feminine equivalent is Trixic.



Toro – An individual who is primarily attracted to men and non-binary individuals, and can sometimes be attracted to women but it is unlikely. It is similar to Uranic, the difference being that one can occasionally be attracted to women. The feminine counterpart is Triniy and the non-binary counterpart is Ebilo.



Tourmalantic – A xenic or xenogender individual who is exclusively attracted to women or feminine-aligned individuals (XLW). The masculine equivalent is Aquamarina and the non-exclusive equivalent is Xenxic.



Trans-inclusive Gay Men's Pride – Gay men's pride flag that includes non-cis (trans and non-binary) men.



Traumahoarder / Traumahoardergender / Traumahoardersexual / Traumahoarderromantic – An individual who hoard trauma related identities such as genderbruised, caedsexual, malneromantic, etc. because they don't feel that one label fits their experience quite right. Since trauma is so complex and impacts such a large amount of a victim's life, some individuals may not be able to distinguish the separation between their gender and/or orientation. This identity is exclusive to trauma survivors.



Triasexual / Tria – An individual who is exclusively attracted to non-binary individuals. Someone who identifies as triasexual can be attracted to any gender under the non-binary spectrum and does not have to be attracted to all genders.



Trisexual – An individual who is attracted to exactly 3 genders. These could be any 3 genders and the attraction could be experienced either as static or fluid attraction. An alternate definition refers to an individual who fluctuates between being bisexual, polysexual, and pansexual.



Trixamoric – A binary woman who is exclusively attracted to binary women.



Trixenflex – An individual who is primarily attracted to women and non-binary individuals, but experiences flexibility in this attraction so that it is not exclusive.



Trixensexual / Trixenamoric – An individual who is exclusively attracted to women and non-binary people.







Trixic / Orbisian - A non-

binary individual who is, exclusively or not, attracted to women (NBLW). A **Feminamoric** is a nonbinary individual who is exclusively attracted to women. The masculine equivalent is Toric.



Turian / Veldian – Gay men and non-binary individuals who usually are exclusively inclusive. It is also called men-loving-men (MLM) and/or non-binary-loving-men (NBLM). Other interpretations could include non-women loving non-women (NWLNW), anyone who isn't a cis woman and is attracted to men (usually exclusively), and many others.



Uranic / Nofemsexual – An individual who is attracted to men, masculinity, and neutral non-binary aligned individuals. It is the attraction to all genders except women and woman-aligned or feminine-aligned non-binary individuals. This orientation is mostly used by non-binary individuals to describe their attraction but it can be used by anyone. Similar terms include Marsic, Mascic, Nowomasexual, Solaric, Torensexual, Toric, and Viramoric. The feminine equivalent to Uranic is Neptunic, and the non-binary equivalent is Saturnic. Its counterpart is Femsexual.



Unlabeled / No Label / Non-Labeled – An individual who does not wish to label their identity with more specific terms.



Varioriented / Vario / Varior / Cross-oriented – An individual whose sexual orientation and romantic orientation are "mismatched," split, incongruous, or mixed.



Varsexness / Sex Vaiancy / Variance – An individual who does not completely conform to the societal and culture ideals or roles of sex including psychic/psychological, mental/neural/neurological, anatomical/biological, skeletal/phenotypic, gendotypic/genetic, gonadal, social, physical/physiological, hormonal, genital and other experiences relative to sexness, whether internal or external, corporeal or incorporeal.



Venufluid / Femfluid /

Finfluid - An individual who is fluid between genders such as Demifem, Neogirl, Lunarian, and/or

any other genders that are feminine. Marfluid (Mingenders) and Eafluid (neither feminine or masculine genders) are Venufluid's counterparts.



Venusic – A Non-binary individual who is exclusively attracted to women, women-aligned people, and lunarians.



Vincian – A non-woman-identified individual who is attracted to non-women. The masculine equivalent of lesbian.

Versatile – An individual who considers themselves to be sexually both a top (the giver) and a bottom (the receiver).



individual who is attracted to men.



Voidpunk – An Ace/Aro individual that rejects human identity and embraces being nonhuman, post-human, anti-human, or cyborg. Currently VoidPunk could be defined as the following:



Wolandalterous – An individual who has a decrease in alterous attraction due to chronic illness, or seeking out alterous partners who respect their chronic illness.



Wolandplatonic – An individual who, due to disability/chronic illness, seeks out trusted platonic partners who will not be ableist and demand sexual and/or romantic commitment.



Wolandromantic – An individual who feels varying degrees of romantic attraction due to one's disability and/or chronic illness.



Wolandsexual – An individual who feels varying degrees of sexual attraction due to one's disability and/or chronic illness.



Womasexual / Womansexual – An individual who is exclusively attracted to women including binary women and feminine-aligned non-binary individuals. It was originally coined for use by non-binary individuals but anybody can describe themselves as womasexual. This term's male equivalent is Masexual.



Womaromantic – An individual who is romantically attracted to women including binary women and feminine-aligned non-binary individuals. It was originally coined for use by non-binary individuals but anybody can describe themselves as womaromantic. This term's male equivalent is Maromantic.



WTFromantic / Quoiromantic – An individual who is not romantically categorizable, being unable to tell the difference between differing kinds of attraction, being unsure about experiencing romantic attraction or not, and/or not feeling the concept of romantic attraction to be relevant to oneself. This orientation is generally used as a catch–all term for individuals who fall in the category of semi-romantic or alternatively romantic, but do not better fit into any other label.



Xengenic – An individual who is exclusively attracted to xenic individuals or those who identify as xenogenders.



Xenxic – A xenic or xenogender individual who is non-exclusively attracted to women or feminine-aligned individuals (XLW). The masculine equivalent is Aquamarina and the exclusive equivalent is Tourmalantic.



Xinsexual - An individual who is exclusively attracted to those

who are xenine in nature or identify with as xenogenders. The masculine equivalent in Minsexual. The feminine equivalent is Finsexual. The non-binary equivalent is Ninsexual. Xinromantic is the romantic counterpart



Xinsy- – An individual who is exclusively xenic loving xenic (XLX) e.g: a preference for Masc xenics but still being attracted to all xenics. Terms under this prefix include:

- Xinsymasc A preference for masculine presenting xenics
- Xinsyfem A preference for feminine presenting xenics
- Xinsyneu A preference for neutral presenting xenics
- Xinsyxi/Xinsyze A preference for xenic presenting xenics



Xyric – A xenic individual who is attracted

(exclusively or not) to other xenic individuals (XLX). The exclusive equivalent is Carnic. The Xyric Spectrum consists of the following orientations:

- **Xenxic** (XLW) A Xenic individual who is attracted to women and woman-aligned genders (exclusively or not).
- Zoric (XLM) A Xenic individuals who is attracted to men and man-aligned genders (exclusively or not).
- Zenzee (XLNB) A Xenic individuals who is attracted to non-binary genders (exclusively or not).
- **Tourmalantic** (XLW) A Xenic individuals who are exclusively attracted to women and woman-aligned genders.
- Aquamarina (XLM) A Xenic individual who is exclusively attracted to men and malealigned genders.
- Carnic (XLX) A Xenic individual who is exclusively attracted to Xenic and Xenogendered.

Zedsexual – An individual on the sexual spectrum from A to Z(ed).



Zenzee – A Xenic or Xenogender individual is attracted, exclusively or not, to someone on the non-binary spectrum (XLNB or NBLX).



Zoric – A Xenic or Xenogender individual who is attracted, exclusively or not, to men or masculine-aligned individuals (XLM). The feminine counterpart is Xenxic, The exclusive counterpart Aquamarina.
